## 2010 JOINT SUMMER PROGRAM IN CHINESE LAW

The Joint Summer Program in Chinese Law provides an overview of the Chinese legal system with a focus on Chinese civil and commercial law. The 2010 joint summer program offered the following courses:

- ◆ Chinese Company Law
- ◆ Chinese Financial Law
- ◆ Chinese Intellectual Property Law
- ◆ Chinese Foreign Trade Law
- ◆ Chinese Foreign Investment Law
- ◆ Chinese International Commercial Arbitration

The joint summer program was held in Shanghai Jiao Tong University Xuhui Campus, located in downtown Xujiahui commercial center. Classes met in the mornings, which left the afternoons and weekends free for field visits, sightseeing, or other activities. In addition to classroom instruction and discussions, participants visited No. 1 Intermediate People's Court and the Shanghai offices of foreign and Chinese law firms. The program also organized sightseeing trips to major cultural attractions in and around Shanghai, such as the Bund, the Shanghai Museum, the Zhujiajiao Water Town, and the Oriental Pearl TV Tower.
